

Hinckley Foodbank Set up Project Manager

Hope Community Church in partnership with the Trussell Trust and Hinckley Foodbank Steering Committee is pleased to be offering the post of Foodbank Set up Project Manager.

We are looking for a self motivated person with proven experience of setting up projects to move the Foodbank initiative forward as a Task and Finish project.

The successful candidate needs to be in agreement with and support the Christian values of Trussell Trust and Hope Community Church, and have the skills to carry out this fixed piece of work outlined below in an independent capacity.

Purpose of work:

- To set up Hinckley Foodbank ready for launch. This includes:-
 - To find and obtain funding for continuation of the project
 - Accessing storage and distribution centres
 - To network with relevant stakeholders, for collection and distribution of food parcels
 - To organise volunteers and ensure training
 - To liaise with the Steering Committee and Trussell Trust
 - To put into place an ongoing business plan with the Steering Committee to ensure sustainability of the Project

It is likely that with further funding a permanent position may become available to manage the Foodbank Project.

Cost of Work:	£1000 (including expenses)

Time of project:	3 months, with approximately 7 hours per week

The worker will work on a contract basis, with Hope CC providing supervision and support to ensure the project is delivered. A desk and office resources will be provided and reasonable expenses remunerated as per contract agreement.
